#### Who Can Apply

Open to all government of Guam employees and the public.

#### **Qualification Requirements**

One (1) year of experience in laboratory work and successful completion of 22 semester hours in biology, chemistry, or closely related sciences; or

Any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the minimum knowledge, abilities and skills.

#### Nature of work

This is routine technical laboratory work. Employees in this class perform routine technical laboratory duties independently after initial training and work under closer supervision on a variety of more complex developmental assignments.

# **Illustrative Examples of Work**

Prepares and runs routine tests and analyses on various substances, such as food, solids, water, air, plants, tissues, and other items. Prepares and labels media, solutions, dyes, stains and other items; assists in collecting, processing and in the preparation of samples. Uses routine laboratory instruments and equipment including microscopes, balances, spectrographs, chromatographs, scintillation counters; moisture, pH, and other meters; and other equipment. Cleans and sterilizes various laboratory equipment, such as slides, test tubes, flasks, pipettes, petri dishes, tubing, and other instruments and media; cleans work space and laboratory area. Keeps various laboratory records and notes, and related laboratory clerical work. Assembles kits for laboratory examinations. Performs related duties as required.

# Knowledge, Abilities & Skills

Knowledge of basic laboratory principles, techniques, terminology, and equipment. Ability to learn and apply basic principles of the physical and biological sciences, as applied to particular laboratory assignment. Ability to perform routine laboratory tests. Ability to handle, clean, and sterilize laboratory glassware and equipment. Ability to follow specific procedures and observe and record results accurately. Ability to work effectively with the public and employees. Ability to communicate effectively, orally, and in writing. Ability to maintain records and prepare reports. Skill in the use of routine laboratory instruments, equipment, and manipulative techniques.

### **Minimum Educational Requirements**

All new employees (meaning not a current government of Guam employee to include reemployment/re-appointment eligibles), shall be required to have a high school diploma or equivalent as allowed by Public Law 29-113 when applying for a position, with the exception of those positions listed on the list approved by the DOA Human Resource Manager.

### **Documentation Requirements**

Applicants claiming educational accomplishments are required to submit official or verified copies of transcripts or diplomas. The diploma, degree, or credits required must come from an educational institution that is accredited or recognized by either its government or a government recognized accrediting agency. This applies to all new employment after October 1, 2008 pursuant to Public Law 29-113. If you wish to claim for any preference points, please read the employment application General Instruction page for additional information. ### Suitability Determination Form

Your employment application will not be deemed completed unless the Suitability Determination Form is completely filled out, signed and dated. If it is not complete or missing from your application, your application for this position will be rejected. Please pay particular attention to question #2. If you answer "yes", you must attach your police clearance that is no older than one (1) month from the date of submitting you application. In addition, please resubmit an updated Suitability form if anything occurred that warrants updating your responses on your Suitability Form after you have submitted your application.

## Prohibition Pursuant to P.L. 28-98

No person convicted of a sex offense under the provision of chapter 25 of Title 9 GCA, or an offense as defined in Article 2 of Chapter 28, Title 9 GCA in Guam, or an offense in any jurisdiction which includes, at a minimum, all of the elements of said offenses, or who is listed on the Sex Offender Registry shall work in any agency or instrumentality of the government of Guam.

# LABORATORY TECHNICIAN I

#### **Examination Requirements**

Written test not required. Applicants will be rated on a scale between 70.00 and 100.00 percent on the basis of their training, education and experience in relation to the requirements of the position.

#### Interviewing Procedures

A personal interview or interview by telephone (if off-island) will be held by the appointing authority or his designee for all eligibles referred via certification.

# **Employment Medical Examination**

All applicants accepting employment must undergo a medical examination and be declared by the physician as capable of performing the duties of the position being hired for.

## **Work Eligibility**

When offered a position, you will be required to provide proof of identity and eligibility for employment in the United States as condition of employment.

#### **Drug Screening**

Applicants selected for and offered employment with the Government of Guam shall undergo and pass a mandatory drug test before being employed. This also applies to employees selected for Test Designated Positions (TDP), failure to submit or pass such drug test shall be grounds for rescinding the offer of appointment.

# Police & Court Clearances Requirements

If selected for this position, your selection will be <u>conditional</u> pending submission of a recent police and court clearance, and taking and passing a drug test (see Drug Screening section of the announcement). The hiring department will mail a letter to you explaining these requirements. You will have five (5) business days from the postmarked date of your letter to submit police and court clearances that are no older than one (1) month from the date of you letter. The cost of the clearances is your responsibility. If you have already submitted clearances with your employment application, you will not be required to resubmit as long as they meet the date criteria above. If you do not have any conviction or conditions that would warrant rescinding the job offer, and pass the drug test you will be notified of your start date.

#### Where to Apply

Submit job applications at the Department of Administration, Human Resources Division 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, ITC building, Tamuning, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Individuals with disabilities who require special accommodation should contact this office prior to any scheduled examinations or interviews.
