### SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

#### 1. GENERAL.

The applicant shall take necessary action to comply with requirements of the solid waste standards and regulations, as referenced in Title 10 GCA, Chapter 51, Guam EPA Solid Waste Disposal Rules and Regulations (GSWDRR), and 22 Guam Administrative Regulations (GAR) Division IV Chapter 21.

The applicant shall be informed of the prohibitions of solid waste activities under Title 10 GCA, Chapter 51, Section 51110(a), which states it shall be unlawful for any person to:

- Place, or allowed to be placed, any solid waste upon the highways, public or private property contrary to the provisions of this Chapter. **Section 51110(a)(3)**
- ➤ Manage solid waste facilities without a permit issued pursuant to this Chapter. **Section** 51110(a)(4)
- Store, collect, transport, process, or dispose of solid waste in such a manner as to degrade the environment, create a public nuisance, create a health or safety hazard, or violate any provisions of this Chapter. **Section 51110(a)(5)**
- 2. DISPOSAL PLAN: The applicant shall submit a written plan for the <u>separation</u> and <u>disposal</u> of waste generated. The plan shall include the following pursuant to **Section 23302(a) of GSWDRR**:
  - Type of all waste to be generated;
  - Amount of waste to be generated;
  - Separation of waste such as construction and demolition debris (C&D), metals, woods (treated and untreated), recyclables, and trash;
  - The company who will transport the waste and the disposal site (Collection, Composting, Storage, Processing, Hardfill, Transfer, or Landfill) must be a Guam EPA permitted Solid Waste Management Facility). Please provide a copy of the following:
  - A letter/contract agreement from the following permitted Guam EPA Solid Waste Management Facility (SWMF):
    - 1. "Collection" Facility who will transport waste;
    - 2. SWMF who will receive the waste; (Composting, Storage, Processing, Hardfill, Transfer, or Landfill)
  - Monitor and record the volume and type of all waste generated and taken offsite. All waste manifest or trip tickets shall be maintained and made available to Guam EPA upon request.
- 3. Waste generated at the site must be properly contained (roll-off bin, dumpster, or approved Guam EPA container); and disposed every seven (7) days or sooner at a Guam EPA permitted disposal facility. 22GAR §§21113(b), (d), and (f) respectively.

- 4. Temporary onsite storage requires notification to Guam EPA. The notification shall include the duration of storage (not to exceed (2) months) and the type of security measures taken to ensure no outside waste is allowed and to prevent illegal dumping.
- 5. Additional time for onsite storage shall require a letter of request for extension to Guam EPA. The letter of request must specify the reason for the extension and any other pertinent information. The letter of request shall be submitted to the following:

- 6. HAZARDOUS WASTE: The applicant shall take necessary precautions to assure immediate and proper disposal of hazardous waste, infectious waste, biological waste, radioactive waste, medical waste, liquid waste, asbestos, animal carcasses and offal, ashes, composting material, decayed matter, putrescible animal and vegetable waste. (Section 23302(a) of GSWDRR)
- 7. EMERGENCY PROCEDURES: The applicant shall have emergency procedures in case of fires or injury accidents and facility preparation procedure in the event a typhoon is predicted to strike Guam. (Section 23104(b)(1)(D) of GSWDRR)
- 8. NO OPEN BURNING: No person shall destroy or attempt to destroy by burning, except in an incinerator, RRF or plasma torch facility the construction and operation of which is approved by the Administrator, or as may otherwise be authorized by the Administrator, any garbage, dead animals or other offensive substances, the burning of which may give off foul and noisome odor. Nothing in this Section shall preclude the burning of trees. (Section 51110(8) of SWMLC, 10 GCA, Chapter 51)
